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About the role

Hult International Business School is seeking applications for Research Fellows to join and contribute to Hult's growing Research Team. This position offers the exciting opportunity to work on projects covering a variety of research topics within an exciting research ecosystem. Topics range from technology within the premise of the fourth industrial revolution to leading sustainability transitions in the context of climate change. Further details on the projects and research topics can be found within Hult's three <u>research labs</u>: the Futures Lab, Sustainability Lab and Coaching Lab.

The Research Fellows will play a critical role in helping the Research Team to implement Hult's research strategy and objectives. Collaboration is a key aspect of the role; Research Fellows will execute all research projects in coordination with other researchers and faculty. The successful candidate will work on a portfolio of projects that will require a range of skills both in empirical and theoretical work. The focus of the position will be to publish high quality academic research in top journals as well as established pedagogic research such as teaching cases. More specifically, Research Fellows will be responsible for the writing of academic papers, and for ensuring successful completion of the publication process.

In addition, the candidate's tasks will include the writing of practitioner articles, case studies, literature reviews, the development of research methodologies, the building of research surveys and interview/focus group protocols, and the write-up of reports. Non-academic tasks will be secondary to the primary goal of publishing high quality academic research.

The candidate will benefit from an active and growing research environment in a global business school, and exposure to a diverse and dynamic ecosystem of faculty and researchers.

 - Pedagogic research such as teaching cases (e.g., Case Centre).
 - Working with faculty on the conceptualization and documentation of teaching cases within faculty classrooms.
- Be available to participate in fieldwork as required by the specified research project.
- Work collaboratively with other researchers and faculty, and with external research providers and/or partners.
 - Undertake a range of research activities within a specified research area, assuming responsibility for specific areas of projects and making use of new research techniques and methods, in consultation with the research award holder or supervisor.
 - This may include fieldwork, interviews, laboratory experimentation, critical evaluation and interpretation, computer-based data analysis and evaluation or library research.
- Collect, analyse and draw insight from qualitative and quantitative data in a structured manner.
 - Undertake quantitative analyses involving data manipulation, statistical testing, data visualisation and reporting, and contribute to the interpretation of results and design of studies.
 - Support analysis on agreed research projects and ensure timely and highquality delivery under the supervision of Principal Investigators/Co-Investigator.
- As applicable, present research at academic conferences.
- Support Lab activities as requested by the Research Manager.
- Contribute to the effective operation of the Research Team and Impact Labs.
- Contribute to the identification of grant bidding calls and to the writing of research proposals.
- Assist Management in achieving the Labs and Central Research's KPIs.



Person specification

- PhD in a relevant field.
- Record of publishing in high quality peer reviewed journals.
- Practical experience within a research environment.
- Ability to develop and apply new concepts able to formulate research questions and develop successful research proposals.
- Expertise in empirical research methods and data analysis procedures (quantitative or qualitative).
- Excellent English writing skills and experience writing for academic audiences.
- Full fluency in English (written and spoken) at a native level or equivalent. Other languages are a plus.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Strong organizational skills (multiple projects will be running concurrently).
- Ability to work independently and proactively with minimum supervision.
- Deadline and results oriented.
- Ability to work well under pressure.
- Ability to work effectively as part of a research community and motivate others to produce a high standard of work.
- Appropriate citizenship or visa to work in the United Kingdom, support for a UK Skilled Worker visa may also be offered.

Desirable

- PhD or equivalent in business purpose and sustainability or a closely related discipline.
- Record of publishing in FT 50 journals and Case Centre for pedagogic outputs.
- Expertise using data analysis packages for quantitative or qualitative data (SPSS, Stata, R, Dedoose, Atlas.ti, NVivo, Otter.ai, Qualtrics or equivalent).
- Knowledge of Generative AI tools suitable for social science research.
